

Rushing Ghosts

Science Experiment



Method

1. Draw a ghost face on to the balloons with permanent marker.
2. Blow up the balloons but do not tie them off.
3. Using the sticky tape, attach some toilet roll to the balloon (near the opening), to make a tail.
4. Let go of the balloon and watch it whizz around the room.

You will need:

White balloons
Black permanent marker pen
Toilet roll
Sticky tape

Method

1. Draw a ghost face on to the balloons with permanent marker.
2. Blow up the balloons and tie them off.
3. Rub each balloon on hair or a woolly jumper to create static electricity.
4. Gently place against a wall and it should cling to the wall.

You will need:

White balloons
Black permanent marker pen

Method

1. Dim the lights (or use a dark den for the best results).
2. Place a torch under the children's hands so the light is pointing towards their skin. Together, observe what you can see.

You will need:

Torch*

Dark den (optional)

*An LED torch is advised as it produces less heat than a torch with a filament bulb.
