

History/Geography

This term we are investigating Ancient Egypt and ancient civilisations. We will be focusing on the role of archaeologists when discovering the past.

English

The main emphasis will be on continuing to develop a cursive handwriting style, practising grammar and spelling skills, particularly practising to highlight the key grammar skills. Pupils will learn these skills through studying a variety of fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts.

We will be looking at fiction (myths), non-fiction (non-Chronological reports) and poetry (shape poems) this term.

Light and Dark:

During this period the children will continue to Work scientifically identifying nutrition for animals (dinosaurs) and identifying skeletons and muscles in animals (dinosaurs).
